I am a public health physician (Epidemiology and Biostatistics) and Project Management Specialist with 10 years' work experience within the Ugandan health system. Since 2016-to date I have been working as the Senior Technical Advisor for CUAMM Programmes in Uganda, where I provide both management and technical oversight for CUAMM programs implementation in Uganda and supports coordination with partners at regional and national level. Before joining CUAMM (2012-2016) I worked as the Medical Superintendent at Holy Family Hospital Nyapea (a rural based hospital of 139 beds) and the in charge Okoro Health sub district in Zombo District.
