Konstantinos Moschochoritis was born in Patras in 1963. With a Degree in Electrical Engineering, he has worked with Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) since 1995 carrying out fieldwork in several countries (Armenia, Liberia, Indonesia, Ethiopia, Albania, Colombia, etc) as logistician and head of mission. He was the General Director of MSF Italy from 2007 until 2013. He's responsible for the management and the supervision of the executive staff, the implementation of policy and the organization of the section.

As logistician/administrator, he has been responsible for the technical-administrative and financial aspects of the projects. As Head of Mission, he has represented MSF with the government ministries, UN and other NGOs; developed mission, designed, implemented and supervised projects.

From 2001 to 2002, he's been responsible for the logistics of the MSF Operational Center of Brussels missions in Liberia, Guinea, Sierra Leone, Ivory Coast and Angola. He's been responsible for the planning, supervision and support of the technical aspects of the operations; international supply, applied security of the mission; transport and communication tools; water and sanitation (in collaboration with the medical responsible); construction, rehabilitation and teaching in technical security modules for MSF expatriates and national staff.

From 2002-2007 he's been Operational Desk Officer for MSF Operational Center of Brussels for the operations in Liberia, Guinea, Sierra Leone, Ivory Coast, Angola, Peru, Colombia, Haiti, Italy and Ethiopia. He's been responsible for the organization and development of operational policy and related issues (e.g. funding strategy, communication strategy, budget management, etc); ensuring the coherence, quality and impact of both long/medium term and emergency programs, teaching modules in various courses for MSF expatriates and national staff, security of international and national staff. Since 2014, he teaches in several post-graduate courses on humanitarian interventions.

In January 2015 he was nominated Director General of the Italian humanitarian organisation INTERSOS.
